

## SURROUND <> VIEW. **STAKEOUT BLIND**

## **SET UP INSTRUCTIONS**

STEP 1: Lay blind with the camo facing down. (fig. 1) STEP 2: While pulling the outside corner up, place your palm on the middle of the hub and press down. (fig. 2) STEP 3: Use same method for opposite side. (fig. 3) STEP 4: Set blind upright in desired location. (fig. 4) STEP 5: To reinforce the blind, stake it into the ground through the grommets.



## **BLIND TEAR DOWN INSTRUCTIONS**

STEP 1: Remove stakes.

STEP 2: Lay blind with the camo facing down.

STEP 3: While pulling a rod next to the hub toward you use your opposite hand to push against the

center (midline) seam of the blind.

STEP 4: Utilize same method for opposite side.

STEP 5: Roll the blind up and put into bag with hubs facing up.
